Old Business:

- 1. Remsburg gave the update on the Frac Tank, Scott Coblentz may be interested. He is going to contact him again to get a definite answer before getting the information to Sowers to advertise on Manure King for \$10,000 thousand dollars. If nothing comes out of that they are going to advertise it as a sealed bid the first of June.
- 2. Remsburg gave the Park-N- Ride update: State Highway will be dropping off the deed at SCD for the Chairman to sign. Remsburg forwarded a confirmation email from DGS to Lee Lambert with a request to process payment of sale of property to the Districts. The total grant has been forgiven.
- 3. Remsburg gave the District Manager position update, eight applications were received, seven met minimal requirement, 6 are local, one out of State. Interviews are going to be held on May 4th and 5th in the vacant office across the hall.
- 4. Remsburg reported he has received 3 scholarship applications. Applications will be emailed to each Board Member for review and numbered 1,2, or 3. At the May Board Meeting a decision will be made on the amount to be paid to each.
- 5. Remsburg reported he has not had time to do a draft of a sign to put up on the road side projects completed by Soil Conservation.

CURRENT BUSINESS:

- 1. Remsburg reported on what was discussed in the April SSCC Meeting. The Minutes were sent out to the Board Members earlier.
- 2. Remsburg reported the County seat to the Board is being advertised from April 15th to the 30th, he is encouraging the Associates to put in an application.
- 3. Remsburg asked about ordering shirts for the new Board Members. There was a Motion: Myers/Flickinger to check into shirts and name tags for Board Members. All in agreement.

- 4. Remsburg reported the State Envirothon is asking for donations to help cover the cost of shirts, he suggests donating \$250.00 dollars. The funds go toward the Endowment. There was a Motion: Myers/Flickinger to donate \$500 dollars towards the Endowment Fund. All in agreement.
- 6. Spurrier is asking for \$300-dollar donation towards the Coloring Contest. There was a <u>Motion:</u> <u>Flickinger/Myers to approve the \$300-dollar donation.</u> All in agreement. Remsburg reported a grant was received from Royal Maryland Council in the amount of \$500 dollars for the Poster Contest.
- 7. Remsburg went over the Quarterly Financials with the Board, a copy was mailed out earlier.
- 8. Remsburg gave the staffing update: MDA has hired Shayne Weister as a Technician and Jamie Snider as a Planner.
